The subject animal, to the best of Sedona's knowledge, is in good health and free of communicable diseases at time of sale. The puppy will have had a full health check, first vaccination, be micro-chipped and wormed before being released to buyer.

If in the case the puppy is to be held with the Sedona for an extended period after puppy is old enough to leave, due to buyers request, the buyer understands that they will be accountable for veterinary costs for the 2nd vaccination if due while still in the care of Sedona.

It is recommended that a licensed veterinarian examine the dog during the first 72 hours from purchase. A full refund or a replacement dog when one becomes available will be given for any dog found unhealthy or unsatisfactory during the first 72 hours. Your veterinarian's written statement of diagnosis, including a detailed description of all symptoms supporting that diagnosis, results of any tests performed, and the reason why he/she feels the dog is a poor health risk must be presented at the time the dog is returned. If the Buyer does not take the dog for a check-up within 72 hours from the date of purchase, this warranty becomes null and void.

Sedona agrees that a rebate of \$400.00 will be refunded to the buyer if a veterinary certificate stating the dog has been de-sexed before it has reached 6 months of age is provided. We strongly recommend that this be done if buyer does not intend to breed. It avoids unplanned pregnancies that contribute to the overpopulation of cross bred unwanted dogs in pounds.

Sedona hold no responsibility for the development of diseases and health conditions that can be caused by the environment, lifestyle, diet and/or improper care of the dog.

Please ensure this is the right puppy for you. We **will** take your puppy back if you no longer want it. But Sedona do not guarantee any refund of money to the buyer for returned puppies. We will consider your circumstances but make no commitment to a refund.

THE BUYER AGREES AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Buyer will provide a safe and healthy home for this dog.
2. That Buyer will have this dog vaccinated and seen by a veterinarian on a regular schedule and ensure that the dog receives good medical treatment and care.
3. That Buyer is responsible for all veterinarian fees for the examination and/or treatment of the dog.
5. That UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES will Buyer ever turn the dog over to a shelter or RSPCA or abandon the dog. If you cannot provide a safe and healthy home, you are to return the dog to Sedona. Furthermore, Sedona will not be liable for any refund of the Total Sale Price.
6. That if Buyer purchased the dog solely as a companion pet, it has been recommended that the Buyer have the dog spayed or neutered at an age determined by your veterinarian, usually between 4-6 months of age.
7. We strongly recommend that if the buyer is to breed their own puppies with the dog, buyer must agree to have all puppies fully health checked. If an unsound puppy is sold on as a breeding dog this will begin can begin a cycle of bad genetical problems. Please be a responsible breeder and choose health over all over aspects.

Special Provisions:

Buyer acknowledges that this written Agreement constitutes the entire Agreement regarding the health, condition, care and loss of the dog between the Buyer and Sedona and that he/she has relied on no oral representation contrary to this Agreement.
